Spreading stormwater awareness

Storm drains prevent flooding in streets, sidewalks, and parking lots during storm events. These drains carry stormwater through pipes and empty through outfall pipes into nearby waterbodies. Stormwater carries pollution, chemicals, and other harmful substances along the way, dumping them directly into local waterways. This is problematic for species that live there and can lead to beach closures and contaminated seafood. Storm drain art is one way to help educate people on stormwater and how to reduce pollution into waterways. 
