

PAPER MACHE RELIEF PLANTS

1. GATHER MATERIALS AND PROTECT YOUR WORK AREA FROM A GLUEY MESS!



- ### MATERIALS
- REFERENCE PHOTO
 - PIECE OF CARDBOARD
 - NEWSPAPER
 - MASKING TAPE
 - PENCIL
 - PAINT - ACRYLIC OR TEMPERA
 - PAINT BRUSHES
 - PAINT PALLET
 - WHITE GLUE
 - SMALL BOWL TO MIX GLUE & WATER IN
 - WATER CUP FOR BRUSHES
 - RAG
 - MIXING SPOON OR STICK

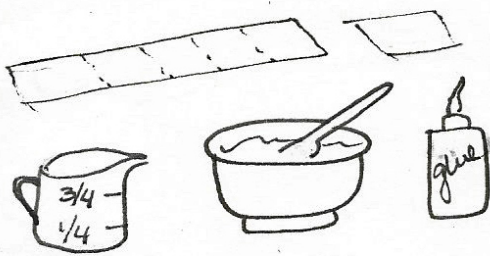
2. SKETCH YOUR PLANT ONTO THE CARDBOARD... MAKE IT BIG!



3. CRUMBLE & TWIST PIECES OF NEWSPAPER & TAPE IT TO YOUR DRAWING ON THE CARDBOARD. BUILD UP THE PLANT WITH LAYERS OF NEWSPAPER SHAPED & TAPED TO THE CARDBOARD.



4. TEAR UP SOME OF THE NEWSPAPER INTO SMALL STRIPS



5. IN YOUR SMALL BOWL MIX $\frac{3}{4}$ CUP WHITE GLUE WITH $\frac{1}{4}$ CUP WATER AND MIX.

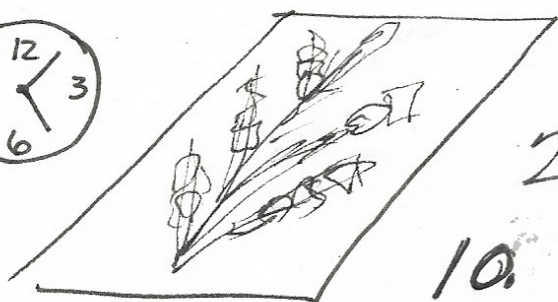
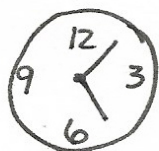
MIX
3 PARTS GLUE
1 PART WATER

6. DIP ONE SMALL STRIP OF NEWSPAPER INTO THE GLUE MIXTURE AT A TIME... USING YOUR POINTER FINGER & MIDDLE FINGER AS A SQUEEGEE TO REMOVE EXCESS GLUE FROM THE PAPER!



7. PLACE THE STRIPS WITH GLUE ON TOP OF THE PAPER TAPED PLANT ON THE CARDBOARD

8. CONTINUE PLACING AND LAYERING PIECES OF NEWSPAPER DIPPED IN GLUE SO THAT THE ENTIRE PLANT IS COVERED 3 TIMES!
 * MAKE SURE THE WET GLUED NEWSPAPER IS CONTACTING THE CARDBOARD!



9. SET YOUR PROJECT ASIDE TO DRY FOR 12-24 HOURS!

10. ONCE YOUR PROJECT IS DRY IT IS TIME TO PAINT IT!

PAINTING STEPS: A. PREPARE AND PROTECT YOUR WORK AREA.

B. GATHER YOUR SUPPLIES... PAINT, PALETTE, BRUSHES, WATER CAN & RAG

C. START BY PAINTING THE BACKGROUND, LET IT DRY. PAINT THE STEMS & LEAVES, LET DRY. FINALLY PAINT YOUR FLOWERS!
